**What Christmas Magnifies**  
**Luke 1:46-55**

"My soul magnifies the Lord,  
and my spirit rejoices in God my Savior"

You can magnify God by reflecting on *who God used* and *what God started* that first Christmas day.

**Who God used (verses 48-49)**

Christmas reminds us that God delights to use \_\_\_\_\_ for his work.

He has looked on the humble estate of his servant.  
For behold, from now on all generations will call me blessed;  
for he who is mighty has done great things for me,  
and holy is his name.

**What God started (verses 50-55)**

Christmas was the time God began to demonstrate his—

\_\_\_\_\_ (verse 50)

And his mercy is for those who fear him  
from generation to generation.

\_\_\_\_\_ (verses 51-53)

He has shown strength with his arm;  
he has scattered the proud in the thoughts of their hearts;  
he has brought down the mighty from their thrones  
and exalted those of humble estate;  
he has filled the hungry with good things,  
and the rich he has sent away empty.

\_\_\_\_\_ (verses 54-55)

He has helped his servant Israel,  
in remembrance of his mercy,  
as he spoke to our fathers,  
to Abraham and to his offspring forever.
