What has he done to bring those benefits to us?

He came down from heaven.

Verse 33: "For the bread of God is the bread that comes down from heaven and gives life to the world."

Verse 38: "I have come down from heaven."

Verse 50: "Here is the bread that comes down from heaven."

Verse 51: "I am the living bread that came down from heaven."

He gave himself.

Verse 51: "This bread is my flesh, which I will give for the life of the world."

What must we do to receive those benefits?

Verse 29, "Believe in the one God has sent."

Verse 35: "Come to me."
