my ears have heard the rout of my wicked foes.

they will grow like a cedar of Lebanon;
- <sup>13</sup> planted in the house of the LORD,  
they will flourish in the courts of our God.

they will stay fresh and green,
- <sup>15</sup> proclaiming, "The LORD is upright;  
he is my Rock, and there is no wickedness in him."
