



### **Stranger Things Revelation 8-9**

**Revelation 8:1-6**, “When he opened the seventh seal, there was silence in heaven for about half an hour. <sup>2</sup>And I saw the seven angels who stand before God, and seven trumpets were given to them. <sup>3</sup>Another angel, who had a golden censer, came and stood at the altar. He was given much incense to offer, with the prayers of all God’s people, on the golden altar in front of the throne. <sup>4</sup>The smoke of the incense, together with the prayers of God’s people, went up before God from the angel’s hand. <sup>5</sup>Then the angel took the censer, filled it with fire from the altar, and hurled it on the earth; and there came peals of thunder, rumblings, flashes of lightning and an earthquake. <sup>6</sup>Then the seven angels who had the seven trumpets prepared to sound them.

**Revelation 9:20**, “The rest of mankind who were not killed by these plagues still did not repent of the work of their hands.”

The Twitter-length summary of Revelation 8-9: *Before we see the glorious things God has promised, grim things will take place in an unrepentant world.*

Let’s break that apart on the next page—

**Before we see the glorious things God has promised . . . (Revelation 8:1-6)**

**. . . grim things will take place . . . (Revelation 8:7 to 9:19)**

First Trumpet (8:7): A third of the earth

Second Trumpet (8:8-9): A third of the sea

Third Trumpet (8:10-11): A third of the fresh water

Fourth Trumpet (8:12): A third of the natural light

*"Woe! Woe! Woe to the inhabitants of the earth, because of the trumpet blasts about to be sounded by the other three angels!" (8:13)*

Fifth Trumpet (9:1-12): Hell on earth

Sixth Trumpet (9:13-19): Invasion

**. . . in an unrepentant world (Revelation 9:20-21)**

**Revelation 9:20**, "The rest of mankind who were not killed by these plagues still did not repent of the work of their hands."
