



All Rise!
Revelation 11:7-19

Point One: Don't let setbacks make you _____ your faith.

(Revelation 11:7-10)

Revelation 11:7 (ESV), "And when they have finished their testimony, the beast that rises from the bottomless pit will make war on them and conquer them and kill them, ⁸ and their dead bodies will lie in the street of the great city that symbolically is called Sodom and Egypt, where their Lord was crucified. ⁹ For three and a half days some from the peoples and tribes and languages and nations will gaze at their dead bodies and refuse to let them be placed in a tomb, ¹⁰ and those who dwell on the earth will rejoice over them and make merry and exchange presents, because these two prophets had been a torment to those who dwell on the earth."

Daniel 12:7 (NIV), "When the power of the holy people has been finally broken, all these things will be completed."

Matthew 24:21 (CSB), "At that time there will be great distress, the kind that hasn't taken place from the beginning of the world until now and never will again."

Point Two: You can't _____!

(Revelation 11:11-19)

Revelation 11:11-12, "But after the three and a half days a breath of life from God entered them, and they stood up on their feet, and great fear fell on those who saw them. ¹² Then they heard a loud voice from heaven saying to them, 'Come up here!' And they went up to heaven in a cloud, and their enemies watched them."

Daniel 12:1-2, "At that time your people—everyone whose name is found written in the book—will be delivered. ² Multitudes who sleep in the dust of the earth will awake...."

Matthew 24:29-31, 40, “Immediately after the distress of those days...³⁰ will appear the sign of the Son of Man in heaven....³¹ And he will send his angels with **a loud trumpet call**, and they will gather his elect from the four winds, from one end of the heavens to the other....⁴⁰ Two men will be in the field; one will be taken and the other left.⁴¹ Two women will be grinding with a hand mill; one will be taken and the other left.”

1 Thessalonians 4:16-17, “For the Lord himself will come down from heaven, with a loud command, with the voice of the archangel and with **the trumpet call of God**, and the dead in Christ will rise first.¹⁷ After that, we who are still alive and are left will be caught up together with them *in the clouds* to meet the Lord in the air.”

1 Corinthians 15:51, “We will all be changed—⁵²in a flash, in the twinkling of an eye, at **the last trumpet**. For the trumpet will sound, the dead will be raised imperishable, and we will be changed.”

Revelation 11:15 (ESV), “Then **the seventh angel blew his trumpet**, and there were loud voices in heaven, saying, ‘The kingdom of the world has become the kingdom of our Lord and of his Christ, and he shall reign forever and ever.’”
