# Belief in hell helps believers respond to the cross with astonished worship.

What would be a bill that if someone paid would be handshake worthy? What would be a bill that would be fall on the ground and kiss their feet worthy?

It wasn't just the physical agony of the cross Jesus was dreading, but the spiritual dimension of judgment. One of his last lines from the cross was, "My God, my God, why have you forsaken me?" Do you see? Hell is the experience of being finally and fully God-forsaken. When we Christians talk about being saved, that's in part what we mean: Jesus saved us from being God-forsaken.
