The context of thanksgiving...

1) Inward

What are times that your thankfulness has been spontaneous?

Gratitude must sometimes come without the emotions but by a deliberate act of the will. There are times I have had to tell myself, "Soul, praise your God." There are times of depression at home or in the office. I have literally had to pull out a pen and write down my blessings so that I could force my ungrateful heart to become thankful. Do you need with thankfulness? Then start with a firm determination: "I WILL extol the Lord." What are some practical practices that help believers give thanks when they do not feel like it?

2) Outward

Read Hebrews 10:24

The word my Bible translates "spur on" is from a Greek word that could be used of a person who incited a crowd to riot as well as a person who rallied a crowd to do good. When you get together with God's people, the fellowship will incite you, stimulate you, rouse you, and spur you on in the Christian life.
