What is your favorite Christmas Carol?

Read Acts 3:1-8

We need to be people of:

Attention

How did Peter and John show attention in verses 4-5?

I can't help but think Luke is saying something significant to us here. Something about how we should pay attention to the needs of the world around us. We're so busy with our jobs or our degrees or our houses or our kids or leveling up on our current video game. I wonder if we've ever done what Simon Peter did and "look straight at" some particular need in this world.

So, do we give generously to the poor? Yes. But we have to admit sometimes our handouts are just ways to relieve our guilt instead of ways to really serve the poor. In Acts 3, God used Simon Peter to miraculously give this lame man the dignity of being able to take care of himself. And I think we need to support the kind of ministries that do that today. Like the old saying, we need to teach a man to fish instead of just giving him fish.
