Get to Know You

If someone mistook you for a store employee, in what store do you think you could help someone easily?

Study the Book

Read John 1:35-51

Seeing Jesus more and more clearly is how we come to faith and grow in faith.

How do the rituals, rules, and organized Christianity help in growing our faith?

How do the rituals, rules, and organized Christianity fall short of fully seeing what Christianity is about?

First Step: Someone we trust speaks to us of their belief in Christ.

How did John's statement in verse 36, "Behold the Lamb of God!" express His belief in Jesus Christ as the Messiah?

Who first told you about Jesus Christ?

Second Step: We consider the Christian faith and believe it ourselves.

What is significant about the phrase *come and see* found in verses 39 and 46?

What steps have you personally taken to discover the truth of Scripture and Jesus?

Third Step: We grow more and more in our experience with him.

Read John 1:50-51

How do these verses relate to Genesis 28?

Be comforted by how perfectly Jesus knows everything about you!

Read John 1:42 and 47-48

How did Jesus see Philip and Peter as who they were and who they would be?

Group Application and Discussion

How does knowing God sees us completely provide comfort during a crisis?

What would you say to encourage someone with this truth as they are experiencing a crisis?

Personal Reflection and Application

What is Jesus seeing in you today? What would you like him to see in you in the future? What steps can you take to make this happen?
