So, the first step you take if you want to make a difference in your world: identify the people who need Jesus. Everything starts here.

Verify their spiritual condition.

Read Colossians 4:6

'Do you find it easy or difficult to talk about spiritual things with others? Why?

Involve them with your church family.

1 Corinthians 14:23-25

What are some ministries that you have invited someone else to attend?

Tell them your story.

Read Acts 4:20

Pastor Tom mentioned four questions that can help you tell your story to someone else. How would you answer one of the following questions:

- What are you learning from Jesus in your present circumstances?
- Why are you glad you have Jesus to give you hope in whatever you're going through now?
- How does Jesus give you worth and confidence that you couldn't find any other way?
- What is your salvation story?

Encourage them to cross the line of faith.
