Get to Know You

If you misplaced your phone, where is it most likely to be found?

Study the Book

Read John 6:63-71

What words did Jesus speak that were full of the Spirit and life?

What did Jesus mean when He said He was the Bread of life previously in John 6?

Faith sticks when you confirm the significance of what you have.

How would you explain to a new believer that the Word of God is significant and life-giving?

Faith sticks when you confirm the singularity of what you have.

What does Pastor Tom mean when he talks about the singularity of Christianity?

Faith sticks when you confirm the source of what you have.

That title “the Holy One of God” expresses Peter’s belief that Jesus is the Messiah for whom they had been waiting. That means he believed Jesus was the hinge on which the door of history turned; Jesus was God’s perfect representative to accomplish God’s perfect will.
