Get to Know You

How many siblings do you have?

Study the Book

Read John 7:1-9

It means more than familiarity.

What was your favorite activity with your family as you grew up?

How can familiarity with church and Christianity be a stumbling block to becoming/growing as a Christ-follower?

It means embracing the resurrection.

In your own words, what does it mean to embrace the resurrection?

Pastor Steve mentioned ten things Jesus' brothers saw with their own eyes. How many can we name?

It means facing some persecution.

Read John 7:7 and Matthew 5:11-12

Pastor Steve told a story about "Christ Followers" and "Nominal Christians" in Beirut. How would you know the difference between a "Christ Follower" and "Nominal Christian" in Austin, TX?

How have you seen or experienced hate, insults, persecution, or slander due to following Christ?

Group Application and Discussion

- 8) Jesus said it was going to happen.
- **91** Thousands of life-long Jews abandoned Judaism and began worshiping Jesus.
- **10)** New Christ-followers formed a church that began changing the world.
